

## LJMTC General Information

Thank you for your interest in the Living Jesus Ministerial Training College, we are glad to have you here. To help you know more about what we're all about, we've included answers to our frequently asked questions below.

**Question: Who are we?** 

The Living Jesus Ministerial Training College is an offshoot of the assignment the Lord gave to His servant, Rev Olusola Ayodele Areogun to help men realise their God-given dreams in life.

The school is aimed at training and grooming men and women for their assignment from God, both by doctrine and by practical ministry, such that they have a life that God approves of and can minister anywhere in the world. It is the purpose and goal of this college to provide our students with quality academic and practical teachings based on scriptural truths. The Living Jesus Ministerial Training College is mandated by God and is designed to stimulate and open the minds of people called by God to walk in their divine calling.

The curriculum is designed to help pastors, evangelists, teachers, preachers, missionaries and others involved in the work of the ministry at one level or the other understand the details of the ministerial work and then function in it with power, integrity and excellence. It is also meant to help believers at all levels in the body of Christ to make a full proof of the ministry they have received in the Lord by providing them with in-depth theological approaches in matters of the kingdom. It is a tool to release sound ministers for the body of Christ.

Question: Who can register? LIVING JESUS MINISTERIAL TRAINING COLLEGE

The Living Jesus Ministerial Training College is an all-inclusive school for every believer regardless of their denomination. **The basic criterion for being a student is a genuine salvation experience.** Whether you perceive a call to be a full-time minister, a part-time minister or you are a believer simply interested in becoming better equipped to fulfil your duty to the world (your Jesus Mandate) as a believer, Living Jesus Ministerial Training College is the place for you!

Admission is determined based on an objective evaluation of an applicant's credentials whatever the background, denominational affiliation or ethnic origin. All are offered equal opportunity to learn. Question: What makes LJMTC different from other seminary or bible colleges?

The LJMTC is a school like no other. This is a college born not out of a man's desire to expand a

territory but a divine mandate to create an avenue for the training and development of disciples

for the Lord Jesus. What more? The lecturers taking various courses in the college are men and

women with a genuine call from the Lord and who are in active service to the Lord so the

teachings they bring are not just a product of much studies but practical real-life experiences.

Question: Who attends LJMTC?

The Living Jesus Ministerial Training College is open to believers from all walks of life. From

university students to individuals at the height of their careers, from single individuals to married

ones, it is a place of destiny training for everyone.

Question: How many years does it take to graduate from LJMTC?

Two years. All LJMTC students must take one of our two-year training programs of study to

graduate.

Question: What are the program options available in the college?

A. 18-Months Full-Time Bible School

As a student, you will be required to attend classes from Monday - Friday every week. There will

be 6-weeks of lectures per semester and then an assessment period afterwards.

In Year One, you will be required to take all available courses while in Year Two, you will be

expected to choose between the 6 available departments in the college based on your

understanding of the will of God for your life.

**B. 24-Months Part-Time Bible School** 

As a student, you will be required to attend classes from Friday evening to Sunday evening (barring Sunday morning). There will be 6-7 weeks of lectures per semester and then an

assessment period afterwards.

In Year One, you will be required to take all available courses while in Year Two, you will be

expected to choose between the 6 available departments in the college based on your

understanding of the will of God for your life.

The colleges include;

- Evangelism and Mission Studies

- Pastoral Studies

- Itinerant Ministry (Travelling ministry)

- Leadership & Governance Studies

- Music Ministries

- Kingdom Management Studies

Question: Does LJMTC offer online training options?

YES. While there are available facilities to cater to individuals who can come onground to the

college in Osogbo for their classes, provision is adequately made for those who can't. All we ask is that students ensure active attendance and participation in the class as this is a requirement for

graduation.

Question: Do I need a University certificate to apply?

NO. While we encourage individuals to pursue as much formal education as they can, this is not a

requirement to be a student. LJMTC only requires that an applicant can communicate in English

and is old enough to have graduated from high school.

Question: When does school begin?

Registration begins at the last quarter of the year and every interested participant is encouraged

to apply during this period.

Question: Is there provision of accommodation for full-time students?

YES. There is provision for a place of stay for students who require accommodation. This is

however made available on a first-come, first-served basis and is subject to a screening process.

Applicable fees also apply

Question: How much does it cost to attend LJMTC?

The Tuition fee for LJMTC is #10,000 monthly.

For a student taking the 18-Months Program, that amounts to #180,000 and for the 24-months program, this amount to #240,000.

N:B: This fee does not include the non-refundable registration fee and is also reviewed before the start of every new session.

Question: What is the payment schedule?

Accepted students are welcome to pay their tuition in full at any time or monthly as earlier stated.

Question: Does LJMTC offer ministerial licensing and/or ordination?

NO. A successful completion of the school programme does not necessarily infer that you have been called into the work of ministry by God. Your graduation however is a testament to your capacity to handle kingdom assignments effectively with or without a title.

Question: How can I apply to Living Jesus Ministry Training College?

**ADMISSION PROCEDURE** 

The prospective student should submit an application before he can be offered a place at LJMTC. In order to qualify for admission at LJMTC, an individual (man or woman) must:

- 1) Be a true believer with an assurance of salvation and freedom from a life of sin.
- 2) Have an eagerness and a deep concern to be used for the salvation of souls without the motive of personal carnal gain in the heart.
- 3) Provide recommendations from a minister who has knowledge and evidence of the applicant's Christian life, conduct and compassion for souls.
- 4) Have a good understanding of spoken and written English.
- 5) Have a working smartphone and a good laptop to be able to attend each class without interruption.
- 6) The prospective student must show marks of adulthood and maturity.

- 7) Students, upon admission, will pay to the Centre the fees prescribed by regulations and register as students of the LJMTC.
- 8) A candidate will be required to sit for an interview as may be set to assess suitability for admission.
- 9) Provide photostat copies of certificates (if any).
- 10) The Training Centre reserves the right to accept or reject an application for admission.
- 11) Pay the application fee.
- 12) Provide a passport photograph (not more than 3-months old as at when taken).
- 13) Submit a medical certificate from a licensed doctor for those that will be coming on campus in Osogbo

Admission at LJMTC is open to anyone who satisfies the above requirements.
